



## Royal University Hospital Foundation 2020–2021 Scholarship Criteria

Please read this information carefully ensuring that you meet the criteria as outlined below. Indicate clearly on the application form which scholarship(s) you are applying for.

**Purpose:** RUH Foundation is committed to supporting RUH medical teams including front-line staff, nurses (NP, RN, RPN, and LPN), medical professionals or post-doctoral fellows to upgrade their skills or further their education, thus enabling them to assume leadership positions in the provision of health care at RUH.

**Source and Amount of Funding:** Funding comes from individual, organizational and corporate donations to the RUH Foundation.

**Tenability:** Scholarship awards will be made annually or until specific scholarship funding is spent.

**Application Deadline:** **May 1, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.**

**Notification:** Applicants will be notified of the results by June 29, 2020

**Award Committee:** A subcommittee made up of volunteers, medical professionals and ad-hoc members will review the applications and make recommendations to the RUHF Granting Committee. The RUH Foundation Board of Directors has the final approval.

**Program and Course Designations and Eligibility Restrictions:** Applicants must be full-time or permanent part-time employees of SHA with the majority of their work at RUH or historical RUH programs including Mental Health and Addictions Services.

Applicants must have a **minimum of one year** of service within SHA.

Candidates must submit a letter of reference from a manager or director who can speak to their clinical proficiency, attesting to their potential to make an increased contribution to healthcare through furthering their education.

**Applicants must submit official proof of admission or registration and validated statement of program costs.**

**Please Note: Conference funding should be obtained through SHA Professional Development Funding.**

**Selection Criteria:**

Selection will be based on criteria being met, the letter of reference, professional goals as outlined in your application and overall quality of the application, other financial support funding requested and scholarship amounts available.

Applicants must demonstrate initiative in the accomplishment of academic and professional goals, have well-developed interpersonal skills and demonstrated expertise in nursing or other inter-professional practices.

Specific Criteria:****Adrienne Eidem Memorial Scholarship: \$1,000**

Applicants must be post-graduate nurses (NP, RN, RPN, LPN) wishing to pursue additional education to enhance clinical skills practice.

**Bernice England Scholarship: \$500**

Applicants must be enrolled in an approved program leading to a BA in Nursing or in a continuing nursing education program of three months or longer such as a Critical Care Course, Oncology Nursing Certificate or Advanced Clinical Nursing Course.

**Bryan Woods Memorial Scholarship: \$1,000**

Applicants must be a social worker enrolled in a formal education program or training that will further their knowledge and skills in a specific area of practice.

As social workers are employed in many programs and services across SHA, candidates will be considered from all program areas of Social Work in Saskatoon.

**C. 'Marcine' Anderson Pediatric Nursing Scholarship: \$1,000**

Applicants must be post-graduate nurse, LPN or NP in Acute Care Pediatrics, pediatric emergency or provide care to children and youth, enrolled in an approved program leading to a BA in Nursing or a Masters in Nursing or other health related discipline to enhance their skills in expanded clinical practice.

**Canada Life Scholarship (formerly known as Great-West Life, London Life, Canada Life Scholarship): Scholarships totalling \$3,000 will be awarded**

**and**

**Princeton Scholarship: Scholarships totalling \$1,500 will awarded**

A NP, RN, RPN, LPN or medical professional (excluding physicians, residents or undergraduate students) working at RUH are eligible to apply. Preference will be given to applicants with limited or no access to any other funding.

**RUH Auxiliary Psychiatric Scholarship: \$1,000**

Applicant must be a RPNs **as well** as a member of the Registered Psychiatric Nursing Association of Saskatchewan (RPNAS). Scholarship to support furthering education, professional development, conferences or an in-service.

**RUH Auxiliary “Dr. Louis Horlick” Heart Health Scholarship:  
\$1,500**

Applicants must be a (NP, RN, RPN, LPN) or medical professional working in a cardiac care area at RUH.

**RUH Auxiliary “Glenn Peterson” Oncology Scholarship: \$1,000**

Applicants must be a NP, RN, RPN, LPN or a medical professional working on Unit 6100 Oncology or providing care to cancer patients at RUH
