Volunteer Services	Furniture for Volunteer Department	New furniture that meets infection control practices in the Volunteer Office to allow volunteers to take much needed breaks throughout the day.
Occupational Therapy - RUH	Tilt-n-space wheelchair (Orion II)	A more supportive wheelchair with a contour backrest and headrest for patients with strength or control issues when a standard wheelchair or bedside chair is insufficient to get out of bed. Vital to reduce pressure sores, improve respiratory function and increase ability to leave their rooms with staff/family and attend therapies.
Physiotherapy Department - RUH	Sci-fit stepper - recumbent step machine	A recumbent exercise machine that allows safe stepping and marching activities to help with strengthening and conditioning for patients with limited range of motion.
Nutrition & Food Services -RUH	A laptop & mobile workstation in the meal tray assembly and huddle area	A computer workstation in the meal assembly area allows the supervisor on duty to connect to necessary computer applications while maintaining daily food service operations.

Brief & Social Detox Unit	2 new hospital beds	Two new beds provide a safe place for individuals under the influence of alcohol or drugs to sleep where they can be monitored by a paramedic for approximately 12 hours until they are no longer intoxicated. It is a an alternative to overnight incarceration or admission to emergency rooms for intoxicated individuals who do not require emergency care.
Oncology Day Center - RUH	Vein finder and a forehead thermometer	A vein finder to assist in the drawing of blood and intravenous access for Oncology patients during cancer treatment to eliminate stress for the patients, their family members as well as staff. A forehead thermomter is required under safe Covid-19 protocols.
