Please read this information carefully ensuring that you meet the criteria as outlined below. Indicate clearly on the application form which scholarship(s) you are applying for.

Purpose: RUH Foundation is committed to supporting RUH medical teams including

front-line staff, nurses (NP, RN, RPN, and LPN), medical professionals or post-doctoral fellows to upgrade their skills or further their education, allowing for more senior and leadership positions to be applied for in the

provision of health care at RUH.

Source and Amount

of Funding:

Funding comes from individual, organizational and corporate donations to

the RUH Foundation.

Tenability: Scholarship awards will be made annually or until specific scholarship

funding is spent.

Application Deadline: April 3, 2024 at 4:00 p.m.

Notification: Applicants will be notified of the results by June 30, 2024.

Award Committee: A subcommittee made up of volunteers and medical professionals will

review the applications and make recommendations to the RUH

Foundation Granting Committee. The RUH Foundation Board of Directors

has final approval.

Program and Course Designations and Eligibility Restrictions: Applicants must be full-time or permanent part-time employees of SHA with the majority of their work at RUH or historical RUH programs including

Mental Health and Addictions Services.

Applicants must have a **minimum of one year** of service within SHA.

*NEW Candidates must include the Manager Referral Form completed by

their manager as part of the application.

Applicants must submit official proof of admission or registration and

validated statement of program costs.

Please Note: Conference funding must be applied for through SHA

Professional Development Funding.

Selection Criteria: Selection includes criteria being met, the Manager Referral, professional

goals as outlined in your application and overall quality of the application, other financial support received or applied for and scholarship amounts available. Scholarships will not be awarded if you have completed the

degree, course or training.

Applicants must demonstrate initiative in the accomplishment of academic and professional goals.

Scholarship Information and Specific Criteria:

Adrienne Eidem Memorial Scholarship: \$1,000

Applicants must be post-graduate nurses (NP, RN, RPN, LPN) wishing to pursue additional education to enhance clinical skills practice.

Bryan Woods Memorial Scholarship: \$1,000

Applicants must be a social worker enrolled in a formal education program or training that will further their knowledge and skills in a specific area of practice.

As social workers are employed in many programs and services across SHA, candidates will be considered from all program areas of Social Work in Saskatoon.

Canada Life Scholarships: \$3,000 & Princeton Scholarship: \$1,500

A NP, RN, RPN, LPN or medical professional (excluding physicians, residents or undergraduate students) working at RUH are eligible to apply. Preference will be given to applicants with limited or no access to any other funding.

RUH Auxiliary Psychiatric Scholarship: \$1,000

Applicant must be a RPN **as well** as a member of the Registered Psychiatric Nursing Association of Saskatchewan (RPNAS). Scholarship to support furthering education, professional development, conferences or an inservice.

Scholarship Information and Specific Criteria: (continued)

RUH Auxiliary "Dr. Louis Horlick" Heart Health Scholarship: \$1,500

Applicants must be a NP, RN, RPN, LPN or medical professional working in an area of cardiac care at RUH.

RUH Auxiliary "Glenn Peterson" Oncology Scholarship: \$1,000

Applicants must be a NP, RN, RPN, LPN or a medical professional working on Unit 6100 Oncology, the BMT Unit or providing care to cancer patients at RUH.
